



SADHA PARTICIPATION AND LEADERSHIP AWARD

The SADHA Participation Award is to be awarded “when applicable” to one 2nd year SADHA member from each dental hygiene program in Indiana. The award will be a one year membership in ADHA, IDHA (not to exceed the current Indiana dues) and the recipient’s component. Students must be selected by the SADHA advisor.

A. Award Criteria

The student must have:

1. Shown leadership qualities in the SADHA organization.
2. Participated in most SADHA activities.
3. Attended component meetings.
4. Attended IDHA Annual Session.

B. Selection guidelines for SADHA advisors to follow:

1. This award is given only when a student meets the entire criteria.
2. It is preferable, but not necessary, that the student is planning to practice in Indiana.
3. The SADHA advisor may solicit input from other faculty members and component officers.
4. Student must show willingness to participate in Association activities after graduation.
5. Selection process must be completed one month prior to the awards ceremony so that the certificate and check can be prepared.
6. Recipient’s name shall be sent to the IDHA Awards and Recognition chair and the President.

C. Presentation of Award

1. The award will be presented during the awards ceremony at each campus by an officer of the component or IDHA representative.
2. A certificate will be presented to each award recipient.
3. IDHA will send a check to ADHA with a membership form for the student.
4. The award recipients will be recognized at IDHA Annual Session during the House of Delegates meeting in November.

Awards and Recognition Committee Guidelines:

In January, the committee shall send the **SADHA Participation and Leadership Award** criteria to the SADHA advisors at each dental hygiene program. Upon receipt of the award winner’s name, the committee shall have a certificate printed and request a check from the IDHA treasurer made out to ADHA for the award recipient.
